

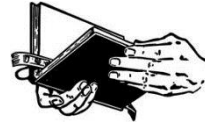

2nd service 10:55 - end of service 1 year - 3 years

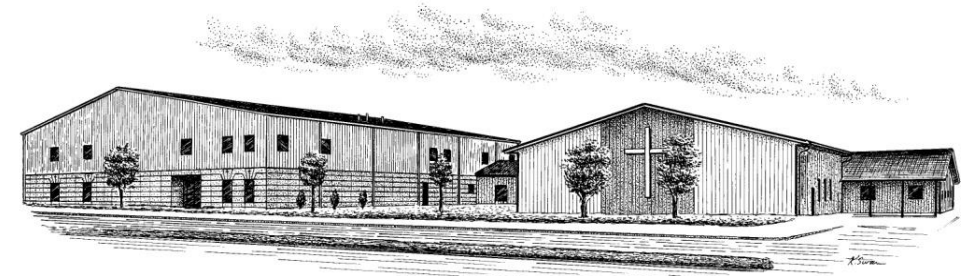

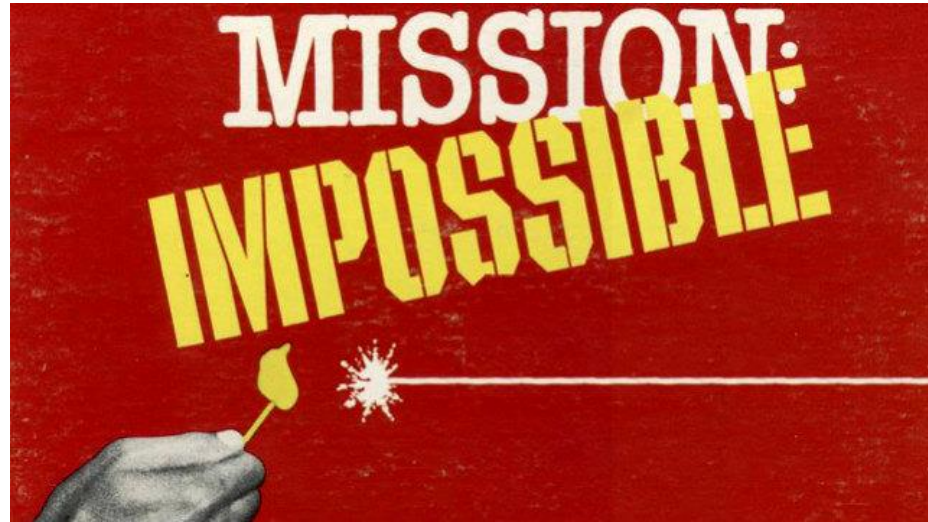
