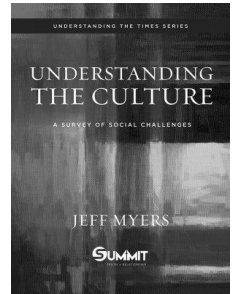


ANNOUNCEMENTS

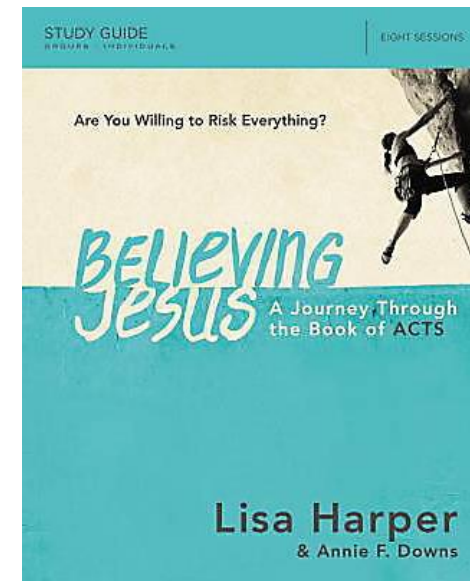

What does it mean to *believe Jesus*? Not just believe in Jesus, but actually *believe* what He said—and shape our lives around that truth? How would that affect the choices we make? The way we see the world? The way we conduct ourselves with other Christians?

In this eight-session video Bible study, Lisa Harper answers these questions by looking at the lives of the believers in Acts and how Jesus' command to spread the gospel forever shaped their lives. Lisa looks at Peter, Stephen and other early believers, and Paul to name a few, making us ask, are we willing to have our lives interrupted by God and boldly share the gospel to the world?

Today, we are faced with the same decisions the early church faced. Will we, like them, truly *believe* the words of Jesus and allow them to transform every part of our lives?
