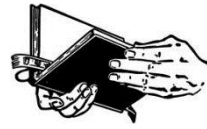
Elders have decided when we move into the new building Sunday service times will be.

WHAT WE BELIEVE

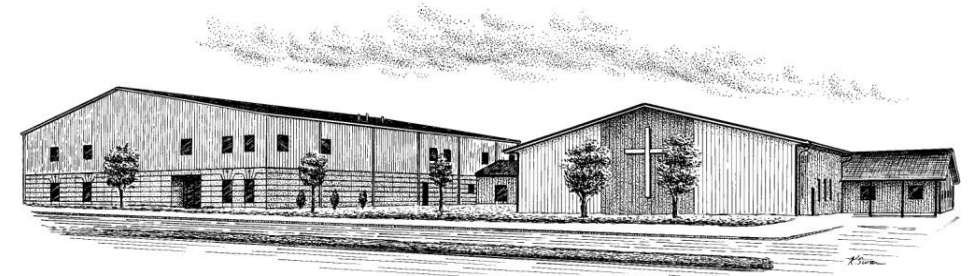
