Hebrews is framed around 5 warnings:

1. Hebrews 2:1-4
2. Hebrews 4:1-2
3. Hebrews 5:11-6:20
4. Hebrews 10:26-31
5. Hebrews 12:12-29

The Warnings Indicate:

- 1) There are consequences to not listening to and applying the warnings.
- 2) There are clear truths to apply in each warning.

2 Major Exhortations

#1 – Hebrews 4:11-16 – A Personal Exhortation

Note: This exhortation can only be applied by an individual.

#2 – Hebrews 12:14-17 – A Congregational Exhortation

Note: This exhortation requires others participant when applying them.

2 Essential Applications

#1 – Hebrews 12:14 – Pursue Two...!

#2 – Hebrews 12:15 – Ensure Grace!

- The War Out There: this talk is an attempt to motivate attendees to ensure they are aware of the battle going on in the unseen realm and to make sure they are prepared to survive and thrive when they leave their familiar Christian bubble (family, church, school) and step into the secular realm.

- Introduction to Worldview: in a culture that is full of ideas coming at us from every direction it can be difficult to know which way is up let alone make a stand for one's Christian convictions. This talk explores what a worldview is, the importance of having one that lines up with reality, and how to spot false ones. The audience will be encouraged to move forward in this seemingly daunting task by learning to look for patterns of ideas that will allow them to begin advancing the Christian worldview in their own lives as well as the culture around them. 1

- The Case for Life: communicating and defending the pro-life view persuasively and graciously.

- The Bankruptcy of Moral Relativism: learn how moral relativism has impacted cultural dialogue on moral issues, and how to respond with truth and grace.

- Tactics: how to discuss your Christian convictions with people who don't believe the way you do. We discuss the best approaches to having productive and grace-filled discussions about Christianity in any setting. This is modeled after the book Tactics: How to discuss your Christian Convictions by Greg Koukl.
