# **Resist Darkness**

November 5<sup>th</sup> is coming up - a big day for our world, nation, and state. One issue on our state ballet will be Amendment G. This "Right to Abortion Initiative" seeks to enshrine a woman's "right" of abortion in the South Dakota Constitution. Terrible! What makes this situation even worse is that "pastors" support it.

According to a statement made by "Faith Leaders for Freedom Coalition," 35 "clergy" from around SD advocate for Amendment G. The document reads, "Freedom Amendment (G) supports those who are pregnant as they make decisions about their own bodies without government interference.
