

"FROM PULPIT & PAPER"

God is a Rock

The Bible uses many metaphors to describe who God is. Among my favorite is this one: God is a rock. Several passages mention this (1 Sam 2:2; 2 Sam 22:3, 32; Ps 31:3; 42:9; Isa 30:29; Hab 1:12). Perhaps my favorite is Deut 32:4, which reads, "The Rock, His work is perfect, for all His ways are justice." God is THE rock. That rocks! What does this metaphor tell us about who God is?

Rocks are stable. They remain in the same place where they are laid and never move. They're predictable and they don't change. I've got a rock on my desk here at the church. Never once has it moved on its own. It just remains where I put it. I can rely on that rock to be in the same place where I put it. Rocks are unchanging, predictable, enduring, and reliable.

God, in many ways, is like a rock. God does not change, for He says, "I the LORD do not change" (Mal 3:6). He is predictable in that He is always good, true, righteous, and faithful. Nothing or no one can change God. Like a rock, God endures. In fact, He is "from everlasting to everlasting" (Ps 90:2). He is reliable and trustworthy, for His word remains forever (1 Pet 1:25). We are not consumed because He is the rock (Mal 3:6).

Next time you pick up a rock, think of God. Next time you doubt God's reliability, examine a rock. God made rocks to show us what He is like. They are the shadow; He is the substance. Rocks point to Him—the faithful, eternal, unchanging, and unchangeable God.



CBC App Directory




The Church Center Directory is an inviteonly place where you can share your contact information and view other congregants' shared profiles.


